Just remember you will not be in your usual groups for this rally. You will be in the grade that you have selected to ride in. All groups including the yard are catered for in our mini combined training. All grades will be doing the C test except for the Invitational, they will be doing the Grade 5A test. The Invitational may be called or led. So, everyone better start practicing their chosen grade.

There are still many jobs that need doing for the Combined Training Day. So please come and see Greg or myself for a job.

We are still selling raffle tickets for the Equitana family ticket. The tickets are \$2.00 each or 3 for \$5.00. The prize is a general admission ticket for a family (2 adults and 3 children up to 14 yrs). The ticket covers a one-day general entry to Equitana valued at \$120.00. 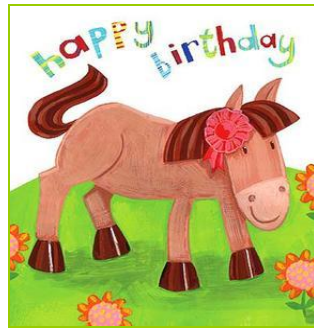
